Tingyi Wang is an assistant professor at the Institute for International and Area Studies, Tsinghua University (2019-). He is now a visiting professor at the Gulf Studies Center, Qatar University (2021-). He also holds fellowships at the University of Exeter as an honorary research fellow (2022-) and King Faisal Center as an associate fellow (2017-). He is also a fellow of the Royal Society of Arts.

He was a postdoctoral fellow at St Antony's College at the University of Oxford (2020-2021) and has previously taught at Schwarzman College at Tsinghua University. He was a visiting scholar at the University of Cambridge (2013-2014), American University of Sharjah (2014-2015), and King Faisal Center (2015-2016). He received BA in Arabic Language and Literature from Peking University (2006-2010), finished the Master of Laws training (2010-2012) and holds a PhD in Political Sciences from Tsinghua University (2012-2019). He also studied at Cairo University, Princeton University and the University of Oxford as a visiting student.
